1. The Google Classroom code for the AICE U.S. History Summer Assignment Google Classroom is **bakdlx7**. It is a requirement for all students registered for AICE U.S. History to sign up for the course Google Classroom.
2. AICE U.S. History Summer Assignment Part 1:
 - Read the following documents: "The Fugitive Slave Acts," "The Monroe Doctrine and American Imperialism," "The Missouri Compromise," "The Fugitive Slave Act of 1850," and "Bloody Kansas." The documents and accompanying questions are available through the course Google Classroom and the Lehigh Senior High School Cambridge page on the school website.
 - For each document, you must answer all of the questions on lined paper. All assignments must be handwritten. Please be sure to clearly label which document the questions are for.
 - The short response questions must be detailed and written in complete sentences.
 - The second part of this assignment is to annotate the articles. For this portion of the assignment, I would prefer you to print out the articles and annotate the articles on that paper. If you are unable to print out the articles, please complete your annotations on looseleaf. You must have a separate piece of looseleaf for each article. Please see the document posted in the course Google Classroom with tips on how to annotate.
3. AICE U.S. History Summer Assignment Part 2:
 - Read Frederick Douglass' autobiography: *Narrative of the Life of Frederick Douglass*. You may choose to purchase a copy of the book (any edition would suffice) or you may choose to read the PDF version posted to the course Google Classroom.

- Complete the discussion questions for each chapter. Discussion questions must be completed on lined paper. Responses must be handwritten. Please be sure to clearly label each chapter.
- Annotate the autobiography. If you purchase a physical copy of the book, the expectation is that the annotations are completed in the physical book. If you borrow a copy from the library or choose to read the PDF posted to Google Classroom, please complete all annotations on paper. If annotations are completed on paper, each chapter must be clearly labeled. Annotations must be handwritten. Please see the document posted in the course Google Classroom with tips on how to annotate.
